

ORDINANCE #33

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE MINNESOTA HIGHWAY TRAFFIC
REGULATION ACT AS THE TRAFFIC REGULATION CODE OF THE
CITY OF UNDERWOOD, MINNESOTA

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNDERWOOD, MINNESOTA DOES
ORDAIN:

1. That the Minnesota Highway Traffic Regulation Act, as now contained in Chapter 169 Minnesota Statutes Annotated, together with all amendments thereto, is hereby adopted verbatim by reference as the City Traffic Regulation Act and shall hereafter control and regulate and govern the operation of all vehicles included within the purview of said Act as the same shall be operated upon any City street, alley or public place in the City of Underwood, Minnesota.
2. Any amendment to, deletion from or change made in the Minnesota Highway Traffic Regulation Act by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota shall be deemed and amended to, deletion from or change in the City Highway Traffic Regulation Act upon the effective date of its passage by the Minnesota State Legislature and shall without further action by the City Council become a part of the City Traffic Regulation Act.
3. The enforcement of this Act within the City limits shall be the responsibility of and under the jurisdiction of the Underwood Police Department whose jurisdiction shall be concurrent with that of State or County enforcement agencies as to State and County highways located within the City limits.
