ORDINANCE #35

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR EMERGENCY SNOW REMOVAL IN THE CITY OF UNDERWOOD, MINNESOTA

SECTION 1

Whereas snow presents many traffic problems, the Underwood City Council makes notice that the snow emergency ordinance shall read as follows:

SECTION 2

Whereas the City Council makes notice that all vehicles be parked off the street as far as possible for the purpose of snow plowing, snow removal, movement of traffic and fire protection.

SECTION 3

Whereas, the owner of any vehicle not complying with above ordinance will be issued a ticket.

SECTION 4

Whereas, a fine of three dollars (\$3.00) will be imposed on all vehicles not parked properly. If vehicles are not moved within twenty four (24) hours after issuance of ticket it will be towed away at owner's expense.

SECTION 5

Whereas, this ordinance will be in effect upon notice and proclamation by the Mayor or City Council and will remain in effect until conditions improve.

This Ordinance was introduced on December 19, 1977 and adopted by the City Council of the City of Underwood, Minnesota, on the 19th day of December, 1977 by the following vote:
