

ORDINANCE #46

The City of Underwood, MN ordains:

I. General Provisions:

- A. Title. This ordinance from the date of its passage shall be known as the Absentee Ballot Counting Board Ordinance, Underwood, Minnesota.
- B. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to Authorize the counting of all absentee ballots cast in Underwood, MN by the county-wide Absentee Ballot Counting Board established by Otter Tail County.
- C. Legal Authority. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to Minnesota Statute 203B.13.

II. Authorization of County Auditor:

- A. The County Auditor is authorized to direct that all absentee ballots obtained by residents of Underwood, MN be returned to the County Auditor for safe and secure storage until election day.
- B. The County Auditor shall deliver the absentee ballots directly to the Absentee Ballot County Board on election day.

III. Designation of Absentee Ballot County Board:

Underwood City Council hereby appoints the Otter Tail County Absentee Ballot Counting Boards as the official election judges for the sole purpose of tallying absentee ballots in Underwood.

IV. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
