ORDINANCE #72

NON-DOMESTIC ANIMAL REGULATIONS ORDINANCE

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS

As used in this Ordinance, the following words shall have the following meaning(s):

A. Animals-non-domestic

1. Livestock and poultry commonly kept for productive purposes on a farm, such as cattle, swine (pigs), horses, donkeys, sheep, goats, chickens and other similar animals.

SECTION 2. NON-DOMESTIC ANIMALS

- A. Non-domestic animals are not permitted within the City limits.
- B. On those lands that have non-domestic animals at the adoption of this Ordinance that are within the City limits can continue to be kept at the current intensity and type of animal, unless said property is sold, rented to another or the animals being kept expires, or for any reason, are no longer on the property. In such case(s) non-domestic animals shall no longer be allowed.

SECTION 5. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

- 1. First time violators of this Ordinance shall receive a letter from the City Clerk along with a copy of the Ordinance.
- 2. Second time violators of this Ordinance will be issued a citation and a \$50.00 fine from the City Clerks office to be sent by certified mail. The owner can request a hearing on the matter before the City Council if the owner contacts the Clerk's office within ten (10) days after receiving the citation. If so requested, the hearing will be held on the date of the next council meeting. If a hearing is not requested by owner, the fine must be paid within ten (10) days.
